

Subject: Annual Determination Notification for Local Educational Agencies Under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and Notification of Selection for Monitoring Activities

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) per 34 *Code of Federal Regulation* (CFR) Section 300.600 requires states make annual determinations of local educational agency (LEA) performance in the provision of special education and related services for students with disabilities. The California Department of Education (CDE) bases an LEA's annual determination on various factors including participation and performance in specific monitoring activities.
