She has compiled her disability awareness teachings in a digital course entitled "Beyond Awareness: Disability Awareness That Matters." Her Beyond Awareness



work has earned her statewide PTA recognitions in the areas of advocacy and outreach, as well as her school's designation of Teacher of the Year.

She has also been featured on several radio programs and television news stories and served two terms on the board of directors of Disability Rights California. She currently serves as a board member of Disability Voices United. Although Diana experiences disability herself, she credits her brother, Joaquin Carson, for her passion for inclusion, disability advocacy, and activism. Joaquin endured years of segregated schooling and subsequent institutionalization. Diana takes the most pride in knowing that after many years of fighting for his release, Joaquin now lives a life of inclusion and quality, in the community, as her next door neighbor.

Danielle Boyer is a 22-year-old Indigenous (Ojibwe) robotics inventor and advocate for youth who has been teaching kids since she was ten. Driven by her family's own inability to afford science and technology education, she is passionate about making education accessible and representative for her community so that no child is left behind.

Danielle creates equitable and innovative learning solutions for Indigenous youths with robots that she designs, manufactures, and gives away for free. In 2019, she created The STEAM Connection, a minority and youth-led



charity that has reached 600k+ children with technical education with an emphasis on language revitalization. The STEAM Connection focuses on the future: ushering in a new age of education via personal and wearable robotics, artificial intelligence systems, and augmented reality utilizing traditional knowledge to uplift and protect Indigenous communities.

Danielle is a two-time invitee of the White House in 2022, a MIT Solve Indigenous Communities Fellow, a Teen Vogue Indigenous Youth Changemaker, an ASA Prize for Equitable Education winner, an EdTech K-12 IT Influencer, one of PEOPLE Magazine's Girls Changing the World, a L'Oreal Paris Woman of Worth, and a Verizon Forward for Good Winner. She currently resides between Southern California and Michigan.


