## Important Updates

### Transactional Reporting for Affirmed Meetings - SEIS Update

Change to transactions created in December and transactions moving forward.

When a meeting is affirmed with the parent signature as NO, a transaction that **only includes the MEET file** is created. This transaction reports that your statutory required meeting was held.

When the parent signature is updated to YES, a new transaction will be created that **ONLY includes the PLAN and SERV files**. This transaction reports what you are providing to the student and how.

Both transactions must be submitted to CALPADS.

Best practice is to submit your transactions weekly.

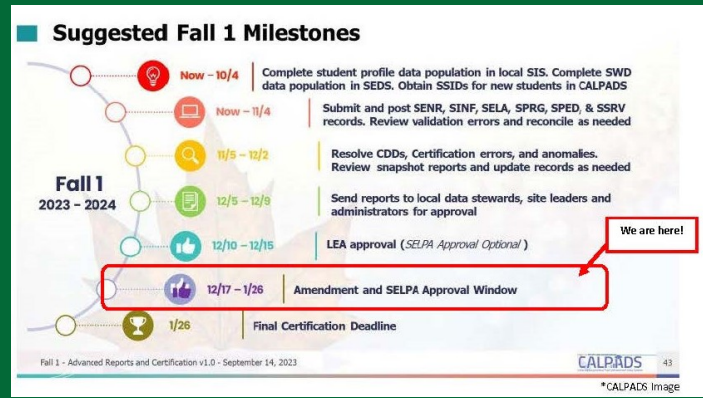
